DAY 1

Start sightseeing tour in Baku.

Visit Highland Park, from where you can have a great panoramic view of Baku city

Ichari Sheher The historic quarter also known as “Castle” or simply “Old City” among the people is the ancient part of Baku, also historic-architectural reserve. Ichari Sheher being the ancient part of Baku was surrounded by well protected castle walls.

- **Shirvanshahs palace / Maiden Tower**

Continue touring new Baku and exploring architecture of XIX- XX centuries: Nizami Street, Fountain Square, Nizami Ganjavi monument.

DAY 2

Absheron Tour + Qobustan Tour 10:00 – 18:00

ATASHGAH (Fire Temple) The temple built in Surakhani village near Baku city by fire-worshiper Indian merchants – Parsees in the XVII century.

YANARDAG (Flame Mountain) The natural monument with no history known, flamed in the result of extraction of natural gas in the territory of Mammadli village, in the coast of Caspian Sea in Absheron peninsula near Baku city.

GOBUSTAN state historic-art reserve – the reserve where the complex of archeological monuments are protected in the territory of Azerbaijan. Also museum acts here. Mainly Mesolite monuments (Middle part of the Stone age) are exhibited in the Reserve. There are caves, springs and etchere. Gobustan was known by Azerbaijani cattle-breeders as a pasture.



DAY3

Baku – Gabala / Transfer & Tour / 10 hours | (One way = 3 hours)

Gabala Nohur lake & 7 Beauty Waterfall

It is situated 3 km in the east of the Gabala city, 1 km in the north from Nohurgishlag village, in the natural hollow between the mountains Gulluburun, Goydag and Yumuru, 700 m higher than the sea level.

Tufandag Summer - Winter Recreation Complex - Ropeways









The complex is situated about 4 km far from Gabala city. The ropeway and ski complex was planned to be consisting of 8 stations. The first station is situated 950 m higher than the sea level and the last station is situated 1920 m higher than the sea level.

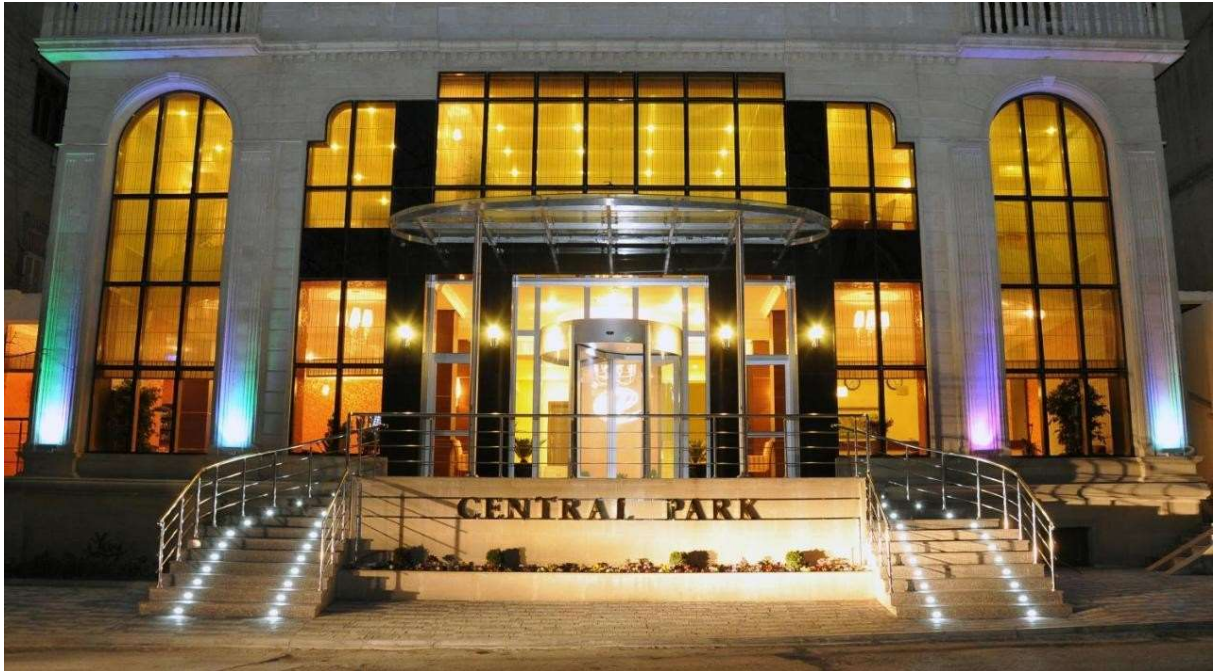

TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS TO AZERBAIJAN

- According to a measure by the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Azerbaijan, dated 18 April 2020, in accordance with Article 25 of the Law of the Republic of Azerbaijan, 'On Sanitary and Epidemiological Safety', the special quarantine regime applied in the country has been extended until 1 March 2023 at 06:00.
- Citizens and residents of Russia, Türkiye, the United States, Bahrain, the UAE, Great Britain, Israel, Hungary, Qatar, Germany, Austria, Belgium, Czech Republic, Denmark, Ireland, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Canada, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Serbia, Singapore, Slovenia, Slovakia, Greece, China, Estonia, Finland, France, Hong Kong, Croatia, Iceland, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Malaysia, Saudi Arabia, Japan, Argentina, Australia, Brazil, Brunei, South Korea, Chile, Ecuador, Cambodia, Costa Rica, Cuba, Kuwait, Kazakhstan, Maldives, Mexico, Morocco, Mongolia, Montenegro, Norway, Oman, Panama, Salvador, Uruguay, New Zealand, Jordan, Cyprus, Ukraine, Romania, Belarus, Albania, Dominican Republic, Philippines, Georgia, India, Indonesia, Iran, Columbia, Moldova, Uzbekistan, Pakistan, Peru, Tajikistan, Thailand, Tunisia, Turkmenistan, Venezuela, Bulgaria, Bhutan, South Africa, Guatemala, Lao, Lebanon, Mauritius, Egypt, Myanmar, Nepal, Paraguay, North Macedonia, Sri Lanka, and Vietnam are able to travel to Azerbaijan by air under the following conditions:

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. Is it safe to visit Azerbaijan in light of the ongoing spread of COVID-19?

The novel coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak, which began in December 2019, presents a significant challenge for the entire world. All travellers are recommended to follow the guidelines instructed by the World Health Organisation in preparation for your trip, and to reduce risk of exposure to COVID-19.

2. Will I be at risk of contracting coronavirus if I visit Azerbaijan?

The Operational Headquarters under the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Azerbaijan is working closely with the World Health Organization to monitor the situation and limit the transmission of the virus. Rest assured, the health and safety of our residents and visitors is of utmost priority and precautionary measures are being taken to minimise risks.

3. Is Azerbaijan restricting travel from any destinations in particular?

Citizens and residents of Russia, Türkiye, the United States, Bahrain, the UAE, Great Britain, Israel, Hungary, Qatar, Germany, Austria, Belgium, Czech Republic, Denmark, Ireland, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Canada, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Serbia, Singapore, Slovenia, Slovakia, Greece, China, Estonia, Finland, France, Hong Kong, Croatia, Iceland, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Malaysia, Saudi Arabia, Japan, Argentina, Australia, Brunei, South Korea, Chile, Ecuador, Cambodia, Costa Rica, Cuba, Kuwait, Kazakhstan, Maldives, Mexico, Morocco, Mongolia, Montenegro, Norway, Oman, Panama, Salvador, Uruguay, New Zealand, Jordan, Cyprus, Ukraine, Romania, Belarus, Albania, Dominican Republic, Philippines, Georgia, India, Indonesia, Iran, Columbia, Moldova, Uzbekistan, Pakistan, Peru, Tajikistan, Thailand, Tunisia, Turkmenistan, Venezuela, Bulgaria, Bhutan, South Africa, Guatemala, Lao, Lebanon, Mauritius, Egypt, Myanmar, Nepal, Paraguay, North Macedonia, Sri Lanka,

and Vietnam are able to travel to Azerbaijan by air under the following conditions:

- submission of an official document issued by the relevant country (COVID passport) on complete vaccination or recovery from COVID-19 for passengers over 18 years of age.

Based on an analysis of the global situation in connection with the COVID-19 pandemic and, in order to prevent the spread of the virus in the country, measures on exiting and entering the territory of the Republic of Azerbaijan by overland means of transport across land borders, excluding cargo transportation, as well as restrictions on international and charter flights, have been extended until 1 March 2023.

4. What precautions should I take when travelling to Azerbaijan?

All travellers are recommended to follow the guidelines instructed by the World Health Organisation in preparation for your trip, and to reduce risk of exposure to COVID-19. As such, all travellers should monitor their health closely at this time and seek medical attention promptly if they feel unwell. If they have a fever or respiratory symptoms (e.g. cough, runny nose), they should wear a mask and call the clinic ahead of the visit. Other precautions to adopt:

- Regularly and thoroughly clean your hands with an alcohol-based hand rub or wash with soap and water.
- Avoid touching eyes, nose and mouth.
- Avoid close contact with people who are unwell or showing symptoms of illness.
- Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or bent elbow when coughing or sneezing and dispose of the used tissue immediately.
- Seek medical attention promptly if you have fever, cough and difficulty breathing.

The use of personal equipment protecting respiratory passages is obligatory in transport facilities used for inter-city (inter-regional) and intra-city (intra-regional) passenger transportations, public catering, trade, work and service facilities.

5. Is it safe to visit Azerbaijan's sights (e.g. malls, landmarks)?

All travellers arriving in Azerbaijan should monitor the local news for closures and restrictions of tourist sights.

6. If I suspect that I have come into contact with the virus, what steps should I take? Will I get access to Azerbaijan medical facilities?

You should seek medical assistance by calling 103 (within Baku), 113 (outside Baku) or 1542.

7. Are Azerbaijan's tourist spots functional?

A special quarantine regime is imposed in the country until 06:00, 1 March 2023. Functioning of malls and shopping centers, shops, museums and exhibition halls is permitted. Inter-city and inter-regional travel is allowed. On-site services in catering facilities are allowed. Cinemas, theatres, entertainment centres in the country are functioning. Sporting events are allowed to be held and people seeing off and meeting passengers are allowed into the airport. COVID-19 passport is required for people above 18 to enter catering facilities, hotels, malls and large shopping centers, cinemas, theatres and entertainment centres.

8. Can foreign citizens get vaccinated in Azerbaijan? If yes, which vaccines are available?

To get vaccinated in Azerbaijan, foreign citizens need to have a residence or work permit in the country. Those eligible for vaccination need to get registered at the local polyclinic according to the place of residence. Currently, people over age 18 can get vaccinated with "Sinovac", "Pfizer" and "Sputnik V", while "Vaxzevria" is administered for people over 60.

9. Are tourists required to have COVID-19 passport to enter malls, cafes and restaurants in Azerbaijan?

COVID-19 passports are required for all persons over age 18 to enter the catering establishments, shopping and entertainment centres as well as hotels, cinemas and theatres, regardless of citizenship. Only COVID-19 passports are accepted, PCR test is not valid for entry.

10. Will COVID-19 passports of foreign citizens be verified by QR code in Azerbaijan?

All COVID-19 passports are preferred to have QR codes for digital verification.

11. Will tourists with COVID passports be additionally checked upon arrival in Azerbaijan?

All passengers over 18 arriving in Azerbaijan should submit an official COVID-19 passport issued by the relevant country (document on complete vaccination or recovery from COVID-19).

12. Has the outbreak of coronavirus caused serious damage to Azerbaijan's tourism industry?
